

# Prerequisites

## *Divemaster*

### Prerequisites

- PADI Advanced Open Water Diver (or qualifying certification from another training organization)
- PADI Rescue Diver (or qualifying certification from another training organization)
- 20 logged dives (documenting experience in Deep diving and Underwater Navigation)
- 18 years old
- Diving physical (RSTC medical release signed by a doctor within past 12 months)
- Emergency First Response certification or hold a certification in First Aid and CPR within the last 24 months from another training organization

### Exit Requirements

- 60 logged dives

## *Assistant Instructor*

### Prerequisites

- Padi Divemaster certifications or qualifying certification from another training organization
- 18 years old
- Diving physical (RSTC medical release signed by a doctor within past 12 months)
- Certified as a diver for 6 months
- 60 logged dives (documenting proof in Deep diving, Underwater Navigation, and Night diving)
- Emergency First Response certification or hold a certification in First Aid and CPR within the last 24 months from another training organization
- If not a Padi Divemaster must successfully complete a diver rescue skills assessment

## *Open Water Scuba Instructor*

### Prerequisites

- Padi Assistant Instructor or as a current Instructor in good standing with another recreational diver training organization for at least 6 months
- 18 years old
- 60 logged dives (documenting proof in Deep diving, Underwater Navigation, and Night diving)
- Diving physical (RSTC medical release signed by a doctor within past 12 months)
- 60 logged dives (documenting proof in Deep diving, Underwater Navigation, and Night diving)
- Emergency First Response certification or hold a certification in First Aid and CPR within the last 24 months from another training organization

\* 100 LOGGED DIVES IS REQUIRED PRIOR TO ATTENDING INSTRUCTOR EXAMINATION (IE) \*
